

The Working Group Meeting on Preparation of Development of the Medium Term Plan for the EANET (2021-2025)

Bangkok, Thailand, 20-21 August 2019

Proposed Session Guidance for Agenda Item 7. Small Thematic Group Discussion (11:15-12:15) and Agenda Item 8. Report from Small-Group Thematic Discussion and Open Discussion (12:15-13:00)

1. Participating countries are free to join three small thematic group discussion with a theme as follow:
 - a. **Current program activities:** include discussion on monitoring of acid deposition, research fellowship, training, current awareness activities, and else.
 - b. **New proposed activities and partners:** include emission inventories, air pollution measures, capacity building on policy, communications of air pollution, and else.
 - c. **Administration and finance:** include the proposal of changing the name of EANET, fundraising, and else.
2. Participating countries that provided Proposed Ideas to one or more themes above are suggested to join the relevant groups to be able to provide their inputs accordingly. Countries with more than one participant attending the WG Meeting are suggested to divide their team into different groups.
3. Each group has one hour to discuss and prepare their inputs in the flipchart (prepared by the Secretariat). A speaker and a notetaker should be assigned for each group. Participating countries can provide inputs based on their presentations and also provide suggestions to other countries' proposed ideas in the flipchart by adding:
 - a. **Name of Proposed Idea** (*brief name*)
 - b. **Arrangements** (*brief explanation on how it will be arranged*)
 - c. **Challenges** (*list all potential challenges in implementing the idea*)
 - d. **Ways to overcome challenges** (*list how the relevant challenges could be overcome*)

If the group could not provide information to some parts, leave it blank.

4. After the discussion and flipcharts are filled, the speaker of each group will present (10 minutes) to plenary under **Agenda Item 8. Report from Small-Group Thematic Discussion and Open Discussion** and followed by Open Discussion.
