### Introduction

- The Work Programme of the Secretariat in 2020 is implemented by following the Medium-Term Plan (MTP) for the EANET (2016-2020).
- The proposed budget to conduct activities in 2020 is developed based on the new arrangements of the Secretariat at United Nations Environment Programme as decided by the IG15 and the “Framework between UNEP and EANET on Arrangements for UNEP’s Provision of Secretariat Services to the EANET”.

### 1. Administrative and financial arrangements

---

- a. Make regular follow-ups with the NFPs regarding annual financial contributions;
  - b. Manage internal UN financial and administrative matters of Secretariat for the EANET;
  - c. Prepare Report on the Progress of EANET and the Financial Report in 2019;
  - d. Develop the Small-Scale Funding Agreement (SSFA) with the Regional Resources Center for Asia and the Pacific, Asian Institute of Technology (RRC.AP/AIT) on provision of support of RRC.AP to Secretariat;
  - e. Develop the SSFA with the Network Center (NC) to support EANET Research Fellowship Programme 2020 and share the cost of managing EANET website;
  - f. Manage delivery of outputs implemented by organization partners or consultants.

## **2. Enhancement of international cooperation**

- a. Make necessary arrangements for two annual meetings of the EANET in 2020 (SAC20 and IG22), including communications with NFPs, travel and logistics, process and facilitation, reports and proceedings and other Secretariat functions;
- b. Provide support to the NC for the arrangement, facilitation and report development of the Twenty-first Senior Technical Managers' Meeting (STM21);
- c. Facilitate the process of development of the next MTP (2021-2025), in collaboration with the NC and the participating countries. Two Working Group Meetings in 2020 will be proposed to be organized to continue make preparation for the next MTP (2021-2025);
- d. Consider necessary revision to the Guidelines on Administrative and Financial Management for the Secretariat and the NC.

## **3. Provision of policy relevant information**

- a. Develop policy relevant reports and publications based on analysis of the monitoring data collected.
- b. Provide support to the NC in the preparation of the Fourth Periodic Report on the State of Acid Deposition in East Asia.

#### **4. Promotion of public awareness**

- a. Organize awareness workshop/forum on prevention of air pollution to promote public awareness in collaboration with the host country.
- b. Develop EANET communications materials and awareness raising materials (Factsheet of the participating countries of the EANET, etc.).
- c. Develop EANET Newsletter in 2020.

#### **5. Enhancement of cooperation and collaboration**

---

- a. Organize a Special High-Level Segment to disseminate information to policy makers, in conjunction with the Session of IG22 and on the margins of the Clean Air Week 2020;
- b. Continuously promote communication and cooperation with relevant organizations and programmes;
- c. Communicate with the participating countries and relevant organizations on activities as well as on relevant regional and global agenda, such as preparation of the Fifth Session of the UN Environment Assembly in February 2021 linking with contribution of EANET, updates on Fourth Forum of Ministers and Environment Authorities in Asia Pacific in September 2020;
- d. Facilitate sharing a common understanding on atmospheric environment issues among the scientific community such as the Asia Pacific Clean Air Partnership (APCAP) Science Panel.

## Proposed Budget for Secretariat in 2019

- Total budget proposed for Secretariat activities in 2020 is **US\$ 720,714**.
- The adjustment of the estimated budget of Secretariat in 2020 above were made to cover the cost of proposed two Working Group Meetings on Preparation of Development of the next MTP (2021-2025) in 2020 pending approval of IG21 Meeting.
- A five-year flat amount of annual voluntary contribution is **US\$ 619,600** decided by the IG17, based on the approved MTP (2016-2020).
- To ensure smooth implementation of activities, the participating countries are encouraged to make their financial contribution or make pledges to the Secretariat in 2019 as early in the year as possible.
- Additional in-kind contributions from participating countries are welcomed.
