on the Acid Deposition Monitoring Network  
in East Asia  
14-16 November 2001, Chiang Mai, Thailand

### Annotated Agenda

1. Opening of the Meeting

The Meeting will be opened by the Interim Secretariat.

2. Election of the officers

The Meeting will be invited to elect a Chairperson, two Vice-chairpersons and a Rapporteur of the Meeting.

3. Adoption of the agenda

The Meeting will be invited to consider and adopt the agenda of the Meeting.

4. Review of the EANET activities since the ISAG3

The Interim Secretariat and the Network Center will present a paper describing the EANET activities since the Third Interim Scientific Advisory Group (ISAG) Meeting (held on 31 July and 1 August 2000 in Manila). The Meeting will be invited to review and comment on the document from scientific and technical viewpoints.

5. Consideration of the national monitoring plans

The Network Center will present an overview of the national monitoring plans which have been submitted to it. The overview will be followed by presentations by participating countries. The Meeting will be invited to discuss and provide comments/advice on the national monitoring plans.

6. Consideration of the data report 2000

The Network Center will present a draft data report on the acid deposition monitoring of EANET in 2000. The Meeting will be invited to consider and possibly endorse the report.

The issues related to data disclosure will also be discussed.

7. Review of QA/QC activities in the participating countries

The Network Center will present the report on inter-laboratory comparison study on soil in 1999 and the reports on 2000 studies on wet deposition, soil and inland aquatic environment. The Meeting will be invited to consider the documents and provide guidance as appropriate to the Network Center.

The Network Center will also introduce a questionnaire survey on QA/QC activities in the participating countries.

8. Consideration of improvement of the monitoring methodologies

The Network Center will present the final draft QA/QC program for the Air Concentration Monitoring in East Asia developed by the Task Force on Dry Deposition Monitoring. The Meeting will consider and possibly endorse the program.

The Network Center will present the progress in preparing the Strategy Paper for Future Direction of Soil and Vegetation Monitoring of EANET that was developed by the Task Force on Soil and Vegetation Monitoring. The Meeting will be invited to consider it and provide guidance as appropriate.

9. Consideration of the work program and budget in 2002

The Interim Secretariat and the Network Center will present a draft work program and budget in 2002. The Meeting will be invited to comment on the document from scientific and technical viewpoints.

The Network Center will propose training programs for EANET in regular phase, based on the information obtained by the questionnaire survey on training needs for acid deposition monitoring. The Meeting will be invited to comment on the documents from scientific and technical viewpoints.

10. Consideration of the future research activities on acid deposition

The Network Center will present a proposal for the future research activities of EANET. The Meeting will be invited to consider and comment on the document.

11. Review of the progress of other international programs on acid deposition

The representatives of international organizations, regional networks in other regions and other experts will be invited to inform the Meeting of their latest activities and relevant scientific information.

12. Other issues

The Meeting will consider any other issues raised by the participants.

After the consideration on other issues, the participants will be invited to visit Thailand's EANET acid deposition monitoring site located at Mae Hia Campus, Chiang Mai University, Chiang Mai.

13. Consideration and adoption of the report of the Meeting

The Meeting will be invited to consider and adopt its report.

14. Closing of the Meeting

The Meeting will be closed by the Chairperson.
