### **Annotated Agenda**

1. Opening of the Session

The Session will be opened by the Secretariat. The high-level representatives of host country will say their address speeches.

2. Adoption of the agenda

The Session will be invited to consider and adopt the agenda of the Session.

3. Consideration on rules of procedure for SAC

Session will be suggested to consider extension of fixed term for SAC bureau members based on the Rules of Procedures for EANET and discussion at the First Session of Working Group on Further Development of EANET (WGFD1).

4. Election of officers

The Session will be invited to elect a Chairperson, two Vice-chairpersons and a Rapporteur of the Session.

5. Review of the EANET activities since SAC3 from scientific and technical viewpoints

The Secretariat and the Network Center will present a report describing the progress of EANET activities since the Third Session of the Scientific Advisory Committee (SAC3) and the Fifth Session of Intergovernmental Meeting (IG5) in November 2003. The Session will be invited to review and provide comments from scientific and technical viewpoints.

6. Consideration on outcomes of WGFD1 from scientific and technical viewpoints including TOR and Work Plan of the WGFD

The Secretariat will present an overview of outcomes of WGFD1 including TOR and Work Plan of the WGFD. The Secretariat and NC will present draft Report of Performance and Financial Reports in 2002-2003. The Session will be invited to make comments and suggestion from scientific and technical viewpoints.

7. Consideration of procedures and plan to prepare the first periodic reports on the state of acid deposition in East Asia

The Report on the First Scientific Workshop will be introduced. The Network Center will propose a draft content as well as procedures and plan for preparing the first reports on the state of acid deposition in East Asia. The Session will be invited to consider the documents and to approve them after revision where appropriate.

8. Review of the Data Report on acid deposition monitoring in 2003

The Network Center will present a draft Data Report on Acid Deposition in the East Asia Region in 2003. The Session will be invited to review and possibly endorse the document.

The Network Center will present a progress on detailed mechanism for disclosure of verified monitoring data. The Session will be invited to make comments and suggestions if appropriate.

9. Review of QA/QC activities in the participating countries

The Network Center will present the reports on inter-laboratory comparison projects in 2003 on wet deposition, soil and inland aquatic environment. The Network Center will present the results of the preparatory studies and a proposal on QA/QC activities on Filter Pack Method for EANET. The Session will be invited to consider the documents and provide guidance as appropriate to the Network Center and the participating countries.

10. Consideration on the revisions of the national monitoring plans of the participating countries

The Network Center will present an overview of the national monitoring plans of the participating countries. The overview could be followed by the presentations on the important changes of national monitoring plans in some participating countries under comparison with the previous year to be done by representatives of participating countries. The Session will be invited to discuss and provide comments/advice on the development of national monitoring plans.

11. Consideration of improvement of monitoring methodologies

The Network Center will present a paper on issues to be discussed on dry deposition monitoring of EANET prepared in consultation with the Task Force on Dry Deposition Monitoring. The session will be invited to comment on the issues for further consideration and improvement by the Task Force.

The Network Center will introduce the activities in line with the Strategy Paper for Future Direction of Soil and Vegetation Monitoring of EANET including a progress on the development of sub-manual on forest monitoring. The Session will be invited to make comments and suggestions.

12. Consideration of research activities on acid deposition including collaboration with initiatives on emission inventory and numerical modeling

The Network Center will present papers on the ongoing research activities on acid deposition including collaboration with existing initiatives on developing emission inventories and numerical modeling. The participating countries will be invited to make comments as well as to introduce their own research activities.

The Network Center will present a paper with proposal on future research activities of highest priority including application/assessment both monitoring data and relevant information to attain the objectives of EANET. The Session will be invited to consider on proposed future research activities of EANET.

13. Updates of other international programs on acid deposition

The representatives of international organizations, regional networks in other regions and other experts will be invited to inform the participants of their latest activities and relevant scientific information.

14. Consideration of the Work Program and Budget in 2005 for EANET from scientific and technical viewpoints

The Secretariat and the Network Center will present a draft Work Program and Budget in 2005. The working procedure on developing of this document will be introduced by the Secretariat. The Session will be invited to make comments on the document from scientific and technical viewpoints.
