



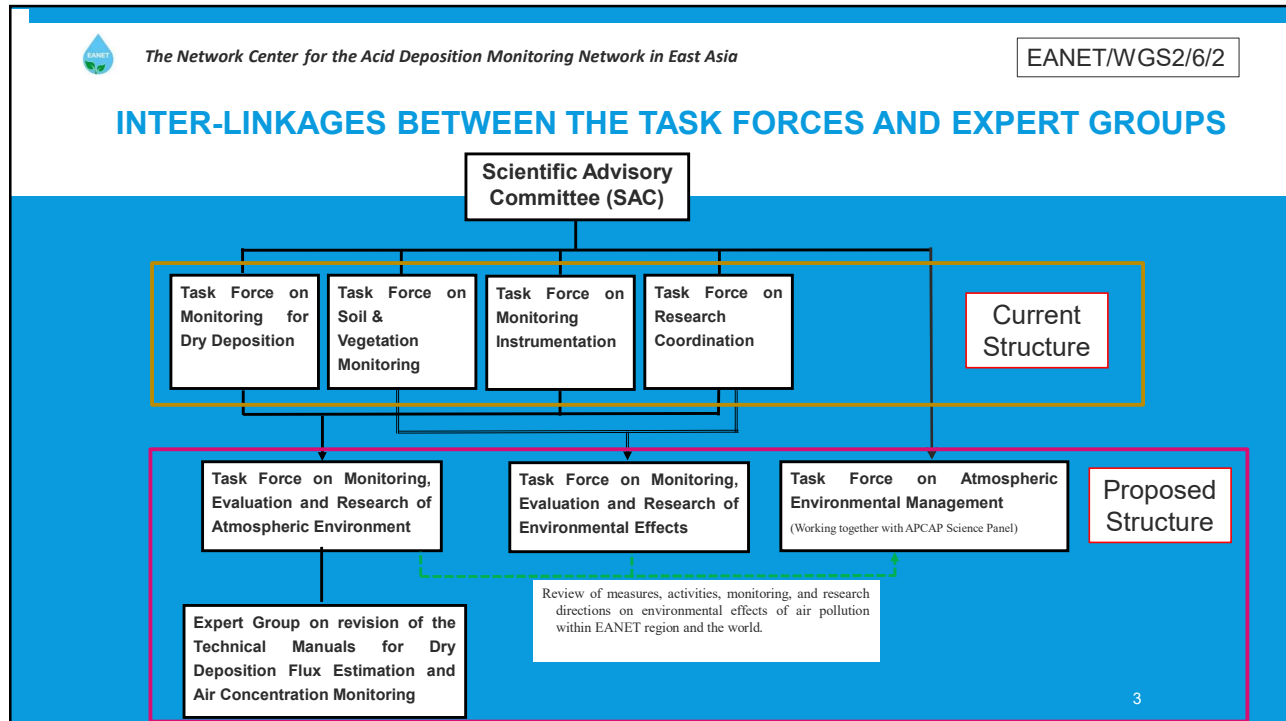
REVISION OF THE TASK FORCES AND EXPERT GROUPS OF THE EANET

The Working Group Meeting Session 2 on Draft Medium Term Plan for the EANET (2021-2025) and Reviewing the Scope of Instrument for the EANET
20-22 October 2020, Virtual Meeting



BACK GROUND

- In the EANET, under the SAC, there is 4 TFs and 1 Expert Group
- Reviewing current TFs' and EGs' activities, however, some TFs are still acting important roles in EANET and some are not. For instance, Task force on Monitoring Instrumentation had the second meeting in 2009, and until 2020 there is no meeting was held and no activity in Task force on Monitoring Instrumentation
- Taking into account the activities in the current MTP (2016-2020) and in the next MTP (2021-2025), the TFs and EG of the EANET should reconsidered.

Task Force on Atmospheric Environmental Management

>(proposed new Task Force)

>To coordinate all matters related to development and maintenance of emission inventories, evaluation of acid deposition and air pollution based on future control scenarios, co-benefit/co-control approaches to mitigate both air pollution and climate change, and investigation (and proposal) of methods to evaluate policy effects, working together with APCAP Science Panel because of their similar objectives.

The detailed Terms of References (TOR), Chairpersons, and memberships of the new Task Forces will be discussed in the next session of SAC after endorsement at IG22 for this reformation.

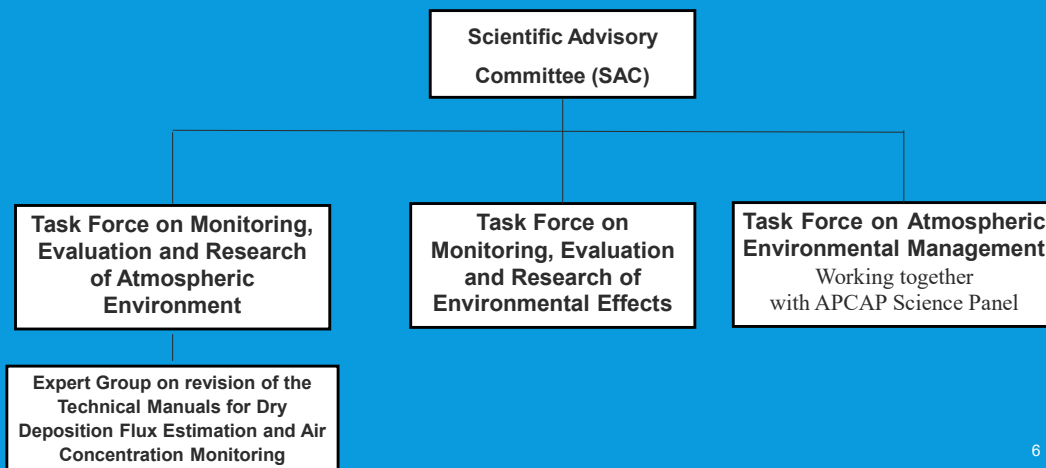
